Target Group	There would be two target groups. Target Group 1 - Grades 7 to 10 (including corresponding extended streams), Form 1 to 4 and Classe de 6 ^{ème} - 3 ^{ème} Target Group 2 - Grades 11 to 13, Form 5 to 7 and Classe de 2 ^{nde} - Terminale
Number of submissions per class	One
Number of submissions per college	Unlimited but with only one submission per class
Description	The class will have to submit a report on the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) their understanding of energy saving, energy efficiency and energy conservation; (ii) the actions or measures they have taken and those they are taking to ensure a judicious use of energy at home and at their college. This shall include any sensitisation and participation of the parents of the students; (iii) other actions or measures that may be taken to ensure a judicious use of energy at home and at their college, with indications of financial implications; and (iv) success stories at their home and/or college in reducing their energy or electricity bill. <p>An educator shall lead the class in this competition and shall submit the report on behalf of the class</p>

Plagiarism	The report shall be an original piece of work and shall be free from plagiarism

Energy Audit Competition



This competition is open to all students of tertiary and vocational training institutions

Description of competition	Participants shall carry out the energy audit of their institution or of a building with an energy consumption of at least 5 tonne of oil equivalent (toe). Participants shall submit a report showing how they carried out the energy audit, measurements and assumptions made, their findings and proposed energy conservation measures, with cost estimates
Age group	18 to 25 years old students (Note: participants should be aged 18 by end January 2019 and be still aged 25 by end June 2019)
Team size	3 to 4 students. Note: no student can participate in more than one team
Number of submissions per team	One
Number of submissions per institution	Unlimited
Language	English or French
Length of report	Shall not exceed 40 pages, excluding annexes
Plagiarism	The report shall be an original piece of work and shall be free from plagiarism
