

# World Energy Day

The World Energy Day was created in 2012 by the World Energy Forum and has been celebrated each year since on October 22. The objectives of the World Energy Day are to raise awareness about energy usage, ensuring the affordability of safe and sustainable energy for all people while targeting carbon emission reduction. These entail the commitment to discuss, analyze, plan and develop national policies to create a set of shared goals on the importance of saving our natural resources, sustainability, environmental protection and the improvement of energy access.

For this year, the Ministry of Energy and Public Utilities organised a workshop at the Caudan Arts Centre to celebrate the World Energy Day with the theme 'Your efforts Count. Act Now'.

The Honourable Minister, Mr. Georges Pierre Lesjongard, officially launched the Workshop which was followed by a round-about of the stands occupied by the different departments of the Ministry; the Energy Efficiency Management Office, the Central Water Authority and the Central Electricity Board.

Other activities included broadcast of the TV Commercial on air conditioning developed by the EEMO as well as launching of the budget measure, 5% reduction in public institutions.
